The 2017 Clemson Heifer Sale sponsored by Clemson University and the South Carolina Cattlemen's Association will be held on February 4, 2017 at the Garrison Livestock Arena - Cattle Complex near Clemson following the 2017 Clemson Bull Test Sale.

Only 19 pens of heifers will be accepted due to pen limitations. A nomination fee of \$25 per head to partially cover sale expenses must accompany the completed nomination and herd health forms. Heifers will be screened by an Extension Animal Scientist for quality, muscling, size, structural soundness, body condition and disposition.
