




We also honored Mr. Bob Rice, Rice Farms, with our Hall of Fame Award! Mr. Bob, we love you!

The 46th Annual Carolina Futurity was held on March 18, 2017 at the T. Ed Garrison Arena, Clemson University. The sale featured an amazing lineup of elite Angus Genetics and was received favorably from buyers that filled the bleachers and were online as well.

The top selling female was Lot 40 from Quail Valley Angus, Roebuck, SC. The 1/16/13 daughter of SAV Pride Mountain 1333 sold with her 12/2/16 heifer calf by SAV International 2020. She was selected by Jim Rathwell, Six Mile, SC at \$7000.00.

Another top heifer calf pair was consigned by Oak Hill Farm, Six Mile, SC. Timothy Banks, Travelers Rest, SC selected both the 10/20/14 daughter of GAR Prophet, safe in calf to RB Tour of Duty 177 and her 10/5/16 daughter by RB Tour of Duty 177 at \$4,300.


